### **Blow & Go Show - No adhesives, Dyes, or glues**

Any cattle not checked in with the Junior Beef Superintendents and exhibitor packets picked up before 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 18, will be treated as a no-show. Exhibitor Check In will be in the South Pavilion.

**All animals must be registered and owned by the exhibitor** as evidenced by registration certificate. Papers must be in the name of the Junior Exhibitor and all papers will be checked upon exhibitor's arrival to the fairgrounds for stall assignments. The tattoo or brand number must correspond with that shown on the certificate. **EXHIBITORS FAILING TO MEET THIS REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION.**

No pending Certificates will be accepted at the time of check in. **Exhibitors Must Present Original Certificates.** Only Exception will be Scramble Heifers and a stamped copy will be accepted.

All recognized beef breeds are eligible. Each Breed must have at least ten (10) entries to constitute a breed show Breeds having less than ten (10) entries will be shown as either AOB or ABC. The following are breeds that met the minimal ten (10) entries to constitute a breed show during last year's East Texas State Fair.

Ring A – English Breeds – Angus, Red Angus, Hereford, Polled Hereford, Shorthorn

Ring B – American Breeds – ABC, Braford, Gray Brahman, Red Brahman, Santa Gertrudis, Simbrah

### **Saturday, September 20, 2008 - 9:00 a.m. - South Pavilion**

Ring A – Exotic Breeds – AOB, Charolais, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Simmental

Ring B – American Breeds – Beefmaster, Brangus

The above listed breeds are subject to change with the number of entries.
