All entries and awards in this division will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the East Texas State Fair Association and Junior Show General Rules.

All entries may be checked by livestock personnel upon arrival to determine health status.

Substitutions may be made only by the same owner, breed and sex.

Rabbits may be disqualified due to Ear Canker, Sore Hocks, Buck Teeth or any other obvious disease. Any Sick animals will be removed from the show at the discretion of the Superintendent.

All Rabbits must have legible tattoo number (may be in black marker) in the left ear. The tattoo must correspond with the tattoo on the entry form.

Each exhibitor must furnish his/her own feed and water bottle.

After rabbits are checked-in, they CANNOT be removed from the Fairgrounds until the completion of the show and subsequent release time.

The East Texas State Fair Association will not be responsible for any animal that may get sick or die while on exhibit or in case of fire. However, all precautions will be taken to prevent this during the East Texas State Fair.

Enter by Breed, not Color – Breed, Sex, ID Number, and Jr./Sr. Designation must be noted on the entry form.

A minimum of 6 entries with at least 1 male and 1 female are needed to make a breed class.
