Special Rules

All rules governing the East Texas State Fair Livestock department will apply to this show, except for the entry fees. Entry fees are \$35 per head or stall space. This fee \$35, must accompany official entry forms and be received by the East Texas State Fair Association prior to the entry deadline, September 1, 2008. The East Texas Longhorn Association will receive \$15 of this entry.

Entries in these classes for this show will be accepted with the understanding that each exhibitor agrees to conform to the rules and regulations of the TLBAA World Show Handbook.

All Exhibitors must be a member of TLBAA.

A photocopy of the original registration certificate must accompany entry application.

All animals must be registered with the TLBAA, be properly identified by brand and PH#, and match the description of the registration certificate.

All animals must be at least 120 days old to be eligible to show.

No grooming chutes are allowed.

All animals will be shown at halter. All bulls and steers will be shown at halter with a nose lead. Group classes will be shown at halter from female age classes 3 - 11 and bull age classes 22 - 29.

Animals must be kept under control at all times. Should an animal become unmanageable, the show manager and/or The East Texas State Fair Management shall have the right and responsibility to remove such animal from competition and all entry fees shall be forfeited.

Substitutions will only be allowed within each show after entry deadline.
