1. Spring Heifer Calves Calved after March 1, 2009
2. Junior Heifer Calves January 1 - February 28, 2009
3. **Champion Junior Heifer Calf** ..... Rosette
4. **Reserve Junior Heifer Calf**..... Rosette
5. Winter Heifer Calves November 1 - December 31, 2008
6. Senior Heifer Calves September 1 - October 31, 2008
7. **Champion Fall Heifer Calf**..... Rosette
8. **Reserve Champion Fall Heifer Calf** ..... Rosette
9. Late Summer Yearling Heifers July 1 - August 31, 2008
10. Early Summer Yearling May 1 – June 30, 2008
11. **Intermediate Champion Heifer**..... Rosette
12. **Reserve Intermediate Champion Heifer** ..... Rosette
13. Spring Yearling Heifers March 1 – April 30, 2008

22. Cow/Calf Pair - any female older than January 1, 2006 with a calf at side.  
Calf cannot be over 270 days of age on the show date is not eligible to show in cow-calf class. In the cow-calf class if the cow is horned and the calf polled then the pair shows in the horned cow-calf class, and if the cow is polled and the calf is horned then the pair shows in the polled cow-calf class. Calf is eligible for individual classes but must be entered in that appropriate class.
23. **Champion Cow/Calf** ..... Rosette
24. **Reserve Champion Cow/Calf** ..... Rosette

- If there are more than 10 animals in a class the AHA show committee recommends that the class be split.
- Cow-calf does not compete for overall champion female

  - Group Classes**
  - 45. **Get-of-Sire** (Three animals shown in above single entry classes with both sexes represented and all to be progeny of one sire. It is permissible to use either the cow or calf from a cow/calf pair for the Get-of-Sire. May be comprised of animals from one or more owners.....**Rosette**
  - 44. **Best of Six Head** Owned by Exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective single entry classes and they must be owned by the exhibitor or by a member of his immediate family. A cow/calf will be considered as two head in Best Six Head class..... **Rosette**
  - 45. **Premier Exhibitor ..... Rosette**
  - 46. **Premier Breeder ..... Rosette**
- Awarded with the following point system - 1st place = 5 points, 2nd place = 4 points, 3rd place = 3 points, 4th place = 2 points and 5th place = 1 point. No points will be given for champions. Points will be awarded for the Get of Sire and Best Six Head for Premier Exhibitor and Get of Sire for Premier Breeder.

The same scoring system as above will be used for awarding points for group classes.
