A photocopy of the original registration certificate must accompany entry application.

All animals must be registered with the TLBAA, be properly identified by brand and PH#, and match the description of the registration certificate.

All animals must be at least 120 days old to be eligible to show.

No grooming chutes are allowed.

All animals will be shown at halter. All bulls and steers will be shown at halter with a nose lead. Group classes will be shown at halter from female age classes 3 - 11 and bull age classes 22 - 29.

Animals must be kept under control at all times. Should an animal become unmanageable, the show manager and/or The East Texas State Fair Management shall have the right and responsibility to remove such animal from competition and all entry fees shall be forfeited.

Substitutions will only be allowed within each show after entry deadline.

Special Rules

All rules in the TLBA & TLBT Official Handbook apply.

Any member in good standing of the TLBT may show in TLBT shows through High School Graduation or Graduating Senior not exceeding 18 years of age on National Show date.

Longhorn calves must be registered with the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America. However, they are not required to be registered in the name of the youth. A copy of registration must accompany all entry forms for verification of age and registration - no pending registrations will be accepted.

Cattle may be subjected to mouthing by a certified veterinarian for verification of age.

Texas Longhorn Breeders of Tomorrow shows are considered open shows. Cattle may be owned by youth, ranch or other breeders of Texas Longhorn cattle.

NOSE LEADS with strap (not tongs) will be used on bulls 12 months and over.

A dress code will be enforced at these shows. The dress code will be: Western attire, long sleeve shirt with collar and cuffs. Western boots and western jeans are to be worn while in the ring. Western hats (not caps) may be worn. Violators of this rule will be disqualified upon the discretion of the show committee.

In Showmanship Class you must exhibit an animal that was shown in competition in the same TLBT Show.

Substitutions will only be allowed within each show after entry deadline.
